Terms and Conditions of Authorisation

1. The authorization shall comply with the provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the rules made there under.
2. The authorization or its renewal shall be produced for inspection at the request of an officer authorized by the prescribed authority.
3. The person authorized shall not rent, lend, sell, transfer or otherwise transport the biomedical waste without obtaining prior permission of the prescribed authority.
4. Any unauthorized change in personnel, equipment or working conditions as mentioned in the application by the person authorized shall constitute a breach of this authorization.
5. It is the duty of the authorized person to take prior permission of the prescribed authority to close down the facility and such other terms and conditions may be stipulated by the prescribed authority.
6. It is the duty of every occupier to ensure that, all the biomedical waste generated is handled and disposed scientifically as per the Rules without causing any adverse effect to human health and the environment.
7. The occupier is required to ensure that, discharge of Chemical liquid waste (Yellow Category) is in compliance with the standards stipulated in schedule – I & II of the Rules. The discharging effluents shall conform to the following limits-

PH	6.5 – 9.0
Suspended Solids	100mg/l
Oil and grease	10mg/l
BOD	30 mg/l
COD	250 mg/l
Bio-assay test	90% survival of fish after 96 hours in 100% effluent

8. The person authorized shall furnish Annual Report, Maintain Records and Report Accidents as contemplated under Bio-Medical Waste Management Rules, 2016.
9. **The occupier shall furnish exact quantity of different category of BMW generated including liquid waste to the RO-Tumakuru within 15 days time for verification**
10. The person authorized shall segregate Mercury waste from the Bio-Medical stream and same shall be stored in a secured place before its disposal as per relevant statute.
11. The applicant shall display this authorization at a prominent place like reception / entrance Etc.,
